## String Competition Guidelines

Except where noted below, the following guidelines apply to *all* the Festival's string competitions, which should be entered online via the Festival's website – <https://northlondonfestival.org.uk/>

- The ***closing date*** for all the competitions ***except*** the and the D'Addario String Prize Competition and the double bass day is ***Friday 27 February***.
- The ***closing date*** for the ***D'Addario String Prize***, and ***the double bass day*** is ***Friday 27 March***.
- For each entry dependent on age, it is the ***age on 1 September 2025*** that applies, so that all the entrants in any age-limited class are in the same school year or years.
- The same piece may not be repeated in different competitions.
- Entrants must be amateurs or music students and are reminded to introduce themselves and the piece(s) they are playing and to wear dress appropriate for a performance.
- Entrants must provide the Adjudicator with a clean copy of the music for each work to be performed.
- If an entrant has been a pupil of the Adjudicator in the 12 months prior to the Festival or is well-known to the Adjudicator, they should contact the Section Head before entering.
- Following advice from an experienced Adjudicator, we have decided ***not*** to allow Festival performances to be recorded, ***except*** by specific prior agreement.

A £500 cash prize and a cup will be awarded to the winner, a £100 voucher\* to the second prize winner and a £50 voucher\* to the third prize winner.

*\*The vouchers awarded are to be used to buy D'Addario products at special festival prices. Winners will be given these prices with their prize vouchers.*

This recital competition is for Conservatoire students of Violin, Viola, Cello, or Double Bass, aged 17 years and over. The recital must include two or three varied pieces taken from Concerto, Sonata, Showpiece or Solo repertoire.

The prize will be awarded not only for the performance of a balanced and well-designed programme but also for the most refined and developed sense of stagecraft. Competitors will find themselves adjudicated not only on the depth of their musicianship but also on how they present themselves and generally connect with an audience. A verbal introduction to the musical programme is an integral part of the performance. Entrants are reminded to wear dress appropriate for a performance.

For each of the graded competitions, performers should play **one piece only** from the ABRSM Bowed Strings Syllabus valid from 2024 or the Trinity Strings Syllabus valid from 2025 or the Guildhall String Syllabus valid from 2025 for their instrument. These classes are to give performers an opportunity to gain constructive feedback on their performance as they prepare for their exam. Every entrant receives a certificate and for each class the adjudicator may award 1st, 2nd and 3rd place medals and certificates. Entrants are reminded to introduce themselves and the piece(s) they are playing and to wear dress appropriate for a performance.
